



NOTICE OF RACE

PHRF Saturday Racing Series 2025

(5 Race Days, 2 Race per day, 10 Races)

- 1. Organizing Authority** – Southport Yacht Club of North Carolina
- 2. Rules** – The race will be governed by Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) for 2025- 2028, including US Sailing Prescriptions, this Notice of Race (NOR), and Sailing Instructions (SIs), published for this series, and any on-water modifications given prior to the race.
- 3. Eligibility and Entry** – This PHRF racing series is open to self-righting monohull 20 feet (length overall, LOA) or longer. Scoring will be based on NC-PHRF rating (see #6 below) for each boat. All competing boats must comply with US Sailing and US Coast Guard safety standards and regulations and have operational marine VHF radio on board.
- 4. Racing Series Fees** – Competitor's fee is \$100 per boat for SYC members and \$150 per boat for non-SYC members.
- 5. Registration** – Completion and submission of the registration form is required prior to competing in the PHRF Racing Series. 7. **PHRF Ratings** - All boats competing must present a copy of a valid North Carolina Performance Handicap Racing Fleet (NC PHRF) rating or promptly apply for the same at <http://ncphrf.com>. Boats not having a current NC PHRF rating shall be assigned a provisional (Base) rating by the Race Committee. If the current NC PHRF rating is obtained during the series and submitted to the Race Committee, all subsequent races will be scored according to the newly assigned PHRF rating. All boats are subject to random inspection by the Race Committee or Protest Committee at any time during the series.
8. **Racing Area** – Ocean races will be conducted on Long Bay, the Atlantic Ocean in the Bald Head Island or Oak Island vicinity east or west of the Cape Fear River main channel. River races will be conducted on the Cape Fear River in Southport, Oak Island, and Bald Head Island vicinity.
9. **Sailing Instructions** – The Sailing Instructions will be made available prior to the start of the series, and they will be reviewed at the Captains Meeting.
10. **Scoring** - Boats must receive scores (other than DNC) in a minimum of 5 races. Scoring will follow PHRF Time-on-Time low-point scoring methodology and scoring will be based on the best of 7 races.
11. **Notices** – Notices and changes will be posted online at <https://www.syncnc.org/> and/or sent via submitted emails of registrants, and/or transmitted on VHF channel 78 at regular intervals up to the published start time.
12. **Awards** – Awards will be presented to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishers in each fleet. *(Note – Determination if there are sufficient boats for a separate Spinnaker-Class will be determined during the captain's meeting.)*

CERTIFICATION, WAIVER AND RELEASE

I hereby waive, release and discharge all claims for damages or death, personal injury or property damage which I may have, or which may subsequently accrue to me, as a result of my participation in this series.

This release is intended to discharge the organizing authorities, The Southport Yacht Club, The Old American Fish Company, Morningstar Marinas Southport, The United States Sailing Association (US Sailing), promoting club officials, any involved municipalities, other public or private entities, and all employees, volunteers, juries, race committees and sponsors of this series from and against any and all liability that may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities mentioned above.

I further understand that serious accidents occasionally occur during boat racing or boating activities and that participants in such activities occasionally sustain mortal or serious personal injuries, and/or property damage. Consequently, I knowingly assume the risks of sailboat racing, boating and related activities and release and hold harmless all the persons or entities mentioned above who might otherwise be liable to me or my heirs or assigns for damages.

I agree to abide by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2025-2028, the Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

I acknowledge that equipment regulations and inspection of vessels are for the sole purpose of ensuring fair competition and do not serve as a certification of safety and that it is my sole responsibility to maintain my boat in a properly equipped, seaworthy and safe condition. I represent that my boat is thoroughly sea-worthy and safe and all equipment on board, including but not limited to safety and emergency equipment, is properly stowed, in good working condition and is appropriate for this series. I further represent that I and any crew permitted aboard the boat are competent and experienced, physically fit, and capable of swimming and treading water in full sailing attire and have been instructed in the use and location of all safety equipment aboard the boat.

I have read and understood the above waiver and the Notice of Race. I hereby warrant that my boat will be outfitted, equipped and handled in accordance with these conditions; that she will have all the required equipment aboard; that she is seaworthy in hull, rig and gear; and that she will be completely and competently manned.

Weather and sea conditions must be evaluated by each skipper and his/her crew, and I acknowledge that I am responsible for determining whether it is safe for my boat to participate or continue to participate in any race, event or related activity of this series.

I give permission for the free use of my name, picture and voice in any broadcast, telecast or print media account of this series in any medium.
